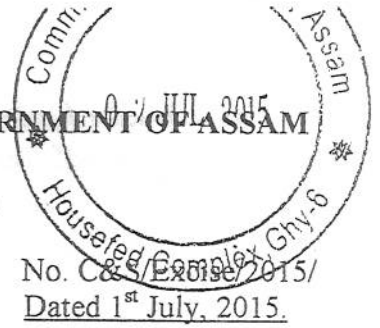

**Action points for Excise Department emerging out of the Video Conference
of the Hon'ble Chief Minister dated 28-06-2015.**

1. Vigorous raids should be conducted against illicit liquor in all tea gardens and surrounding areas.
(Action – CE Assam)
2. Weekly report of action taken in this regard should be submitted to Hon'ble Chief Minister's Office.
(Action – CE Assam)
3. Commissioner of Excise will gather information of illicit liquor manufacturers and take action against them within 7 days.
(Action – CE Assam)
4. The third party evaluation of the action taken against illicit liquor should be done every month.
(Action – CE Assam)
5. One toll free number should be installed by the Commissioner of Excise at the earliest for receiving complaints from citizens. The toll free number should be publicized through advertisements in TV, FM, Newspapers etc.
(Action – CE Assam)
6. A Joint Working Group may be formed with local Inspector of Excise, Tea Garden Manager of the concerned gardens and the Officer in charge of the local Police Station for conducting raids against illicit liquor.
(Action – DCs)
7. An ordinance should be prepared to strengthen the penal provisions of the Assam Excise Act, 1910 by 31st July, 2015.
(Action – Excise Department)
8. District level awareness committee for creating awareness against unhealthy alcoholism to be constituted under the Chairmanship of the Deputy Commissioner with the following members :
 - a. Deputy Commissioner – Chairman.
 - b. Superintendent of Police.
 - c. Superintendent of Excise – Member Secretary.
 - d. Joint Director of Health Services.
 - e. District Social Welfare Officer.
 - f. Assistant Labour Commissioner / Labour Officer.
 - g. District Information and Public Relation Officer.
 - h. Representatives of Tea Associations.
 - i. Representatives of Workers Unions.
 - j. All managers of the tea gardens of the district.
 - k. Representatives of the Mother Club
 - l. Representatives of SADPC.

District level plan for creating awareness should be made by the District level awareness committees by 3rd or 4th week of July.

✓ 10.

The State Anti Drug and Prohibition Council will activate its units in the tea garden areas for creating awareness. It will provide the necessary support to district level awareness committees. (I/c State Anti Drug & Prohibition Council)

✓ 11.

Tea garden level prohibition committee should be formed with the following members:

- a. Circle Officer - Chairman
- b. Inspector of Excise.
- c. Local Medical Officer. //
- d. Manager of tea garden – Convener
- e. Labour Welfare Officer
- f. Local Head Master
- g. Representatives of Workers Union
- h. Representatives of Mother Club
- i. Representatives of ICDs
- j. Representatives of ASHA workers
- k. Representatives of SADPC //
